## Blackboard Ink, black

The blackboard ink Series 388-3106/33 was developed for classic blackboard applications. On suitable substrates, a durable, resistant coating is created which can be written on with chalk reversibly and in a long-term manner. Typically, the series is used to produce full-surface or partial labelling fields for promotional material in the catering sector and is characterised by its good acceptance of chalk and easy cleaning.

In coordination with the substrate and if implemented correctly, this system can also be used outdoors without difficulty.

On request, besides black, nearly any other color shade can be realised using this technology.
